## **IMPORTANT REMINDER: ACCEPTABLE BEHAVIOUR ON SCHOOL SITE**

Thank you very much to the huge majority of parents and visitors that are always polite and courteous, and who set a good model of behaviour for our children when they come onto school site.

Unfortunately, recently we have had some incidents of unacceptable parental behaviour on school site.

**In particular, we will not tolerate the following behaviours by parents/carers/visitors, and we will take swift action if such behaviours are demonstrated:**

- Using loud and/or offensive language. *Offensive language includes: swearing, or using language that is racist, sexist, homophobic or disrespectful towards another's faith or religious beliefs;*
- The use of physical or verbal aggression towards another adult or child.

**We do expect parents, carers and visitors to support a safe environment by:**

- Understanding that both teachers and parents need to work together for the benefit of their children;
- Acknowledging that all members of the school community should be treated with respect;
- Setting a good example with their own use of polite language and appropriate behaviour.
