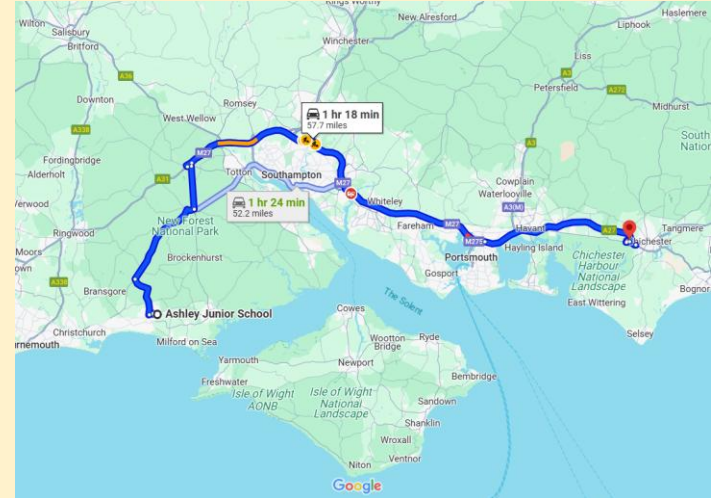

Year 3 History trip - Fishbourne Roman Palace and Gardens – 10th June 2026

In the summer term, we will be learning about The Romans in History.

To support this, we are very excited to share with you details about a day trip to Fishbourne Roman Palace and Gardens on Wednesday 10th June.

The children will be participating in an exciting, hands-on workshop where they will have the opportunity to write on wax tablets, build an arch and dress up in typical Roman attire. There will also be an opportunity to look around the palace, mosaics and gardens.

Fishbourne is just outside Chichester. We will be travelling by coach and leaving school that day at 08:40am prompt and then returning in time for the end of the school day. We will be very grateful if the children could arrive at 08:20am so we can get on the road as soon as possible in order to arrive at the venue around 10:00am. All pupils are to be in school uniform.

Everyone will need to bring a packed lunch with them. Children who are entitled to free school meals will have a picnic meal provided by the school unless otherwise stated by you.

With the kind donation from the PTA, we are delighted to say the cost of the trip is has been reduced to £18.20 per child, which pays for entrance fees and workshops.

You will be able to make payment via your child's Arbor account deadline for contributions is 9:00am Friday 1st May 2025. Although we can only ask that this is a voluntary contribution should there be insufficient contributions, the school reserves the right to cancel or postpone the visit.

We hope you agree that a trip off site to learn more about the Romans and their legacy will be an exciting day for the children.

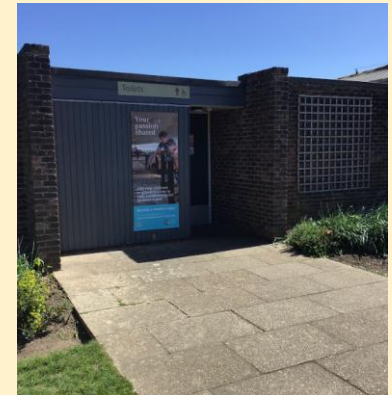

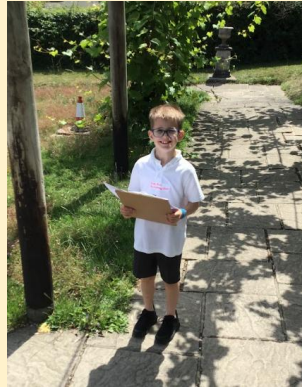
