Who are ActiveMe 360?

ActiveMe 360 are a local, experienced provider of wraparound care and holiday programmes in schools across Hampshire, West Sussex and Wiltshire. Their team uses sport, physical activity, creative play and wellbeing activities to help children feel happy, active and confident before and after the school day.

As a Social Enterprise, they reinvest a significant proportion of their profits back into programmes that support local communities, children and families.

What will wraparound care look like at AJS?

From September, ActiveMe 360 will run Ofsted-registered Breakfast Clubs, After School Clubs and Extended Care for pupils from both Ashley Infant and Ashley Junior Schools, based in a dedicated room at Ashley Junior School. Children will be walked safely to and from the Infant School as needed.

Each day after school, children will be able to choose from two club-style sessions straight after the end of the school day: a sports-focused club that follows a weekly pattern, and a creative/activity-based club for children who prefer that style of session. These club sessions will then be followed by an extended wraparound care session for children who need childcare later into the afternoon/early evening. Final timings and full details of the clubs and extended care options will be confirmed in a further update.

Creative Club Weekly themes

Each week will follow a different theme, linked to ideas such as creativity, nature, our world, wellbeing and working together. Children might be building and designing one week, exploring science and the outdoors another, or taking part in global or community-themed challenges the next. This approach keeps activities fresh while maintaining clear routines that help children feel settled and secure.



Across the week, children can look forward to a varied timetable of activities, for example:

- **Sports and team games**
- **Creative clubs such as arts and crafts, construction and STEM activities**
- **“Fun with Food” style sessions and themed challenges**
- **Calm spaces for reading, homework or quiet time**

Sessions are structured and age-appropriate from Reception to Year 6.

Food, care and wellbeing

Breakfast club will include a simple, healthy breakfast. During the first part of the after-school session, all children will have access to fruit and light snacks such as rice cakes and breadsticks. Children who stay on for the extended session will also be offered a more substantial meat-free snack, provided on a two-week rolling menu.

All staff are trained to support children's safety, wellbeing and positive behaviour, working in line with the schools' values and expectations.



Flexible for families

The service is designed to offer flexible booking options so you can book regular days, individual sessions or a mix of both, subject to availability. Universal Credit Childcare payments, Childcare vouchers and Tax-Free Childcare are accepted; further information about payment options will be included with the booking details.

Holiday camps – an additional option

Alongside term-time wraparound care, ActiveMe 360 also run Active Holiday camps at a number of local venues, offering high-quality, affordable childcare during school holidays with a mix of sports, games and creative activities. We are also in discussions about hosting an Active Holiday Camp at Ashley Junior School and will share more information in due course. If it goes ahead, it will not commence until October Half Term or Christmas 2026.
