Year 6 production of Pirates of the Curry Bean.

Monday 6th July - Afternoon performance 1:45pm

We hope that your child is excited and diligently learning their parts and the songs for this year's production of Pirates of the Curry Bean! The children are working really hard during their rehearsals at school. At the end of last week, you should have received an email detailing the part/s your child will be playing. We greatly appreciate your help in putting together their costumes.

Performance Times and Tickets

The afternoon performance is scheduled to begin at 1:45pm. If you have babies and/or very young children, we encourage you to bring them along to this performance, as they can sit on your lap and do not require their own seat.

To comply with fire regulations, please note that seats will be limited to 2 per pupil for both the afternoon and evening show. To help fund the production, we have set seat prices at £2 each. The funds raised will contribute to the upkeep of props and materials necessary for the school production. Tickets are available for purchase via Arbor in the school shop; simply select the afternoon and/or evening performance for the Year 6 Production.

We will be checking our Arbor records for ticket purchases when the audience arrives at each performance – please ensure you have bought your allocated seats beforehand. *It is essential to enforce fire regulations regarding AJS hall capacity; please note that no purchase of Arbor seats = no entry to the afternoon/evening performance. Thank you for your understanding.*

Filming

To ensure a safe and respectful environment for all participants, we kindly ask that you refrain from taking photographs and/or filming during the performance.
