Year 6 Activity Day – Tuesday 14th July

Following our recent communication regarding the cancellation of the Monkey World trip, we are delighted to share details of a special end-of-year activity day that we have arranged for all Year 6 pupils.

On **Tuesday 14th July**, we will be welcoming **Fresh Air Club** to Ashley Junior School to deliver an exciting outdoor activity day packed with fun, challenge and teamwork. This promises to be a memorable experience and a fantastic way for our Year 6 children to celebrate the end of their primary school journey together.

Throughout the day, pupils will take part in a range of instructor-led activities, rotating around different stations in groups. Activities will include:

- **Archery** – learning how to aim and hit the target like a true archer.
- **Axe Throwing** – a safe and supervised opportunity to develop accuracy and technique in this increasingly popular outdoor sport.
- **Airsoft Target Challenge** – putting concentration, coordination and precision to the test through a series of exciting target-shooting challenges.
- **Outdoor Craft Activity** – a creative session where children can make and take home something special to remember the day.

The activities have been carefully chosen to promote confidence, resilience, teamwork and problem-solving skills, while ensuring that the children have lots of fun. All sessions will be led by experienced instructors from Fresh Air Club and will be fully risk assessed.

To make the most of the day, we ask that the children:

- Wear their **PE kit** and suitable footwear.
- Bring a **sun hat**.
- Apply **sun cream** before coming to school and bring a named bottle if they are able to reapply it independently.
- Bring a **packed lunch**, as we will be enjoying a picnic lunch together on the school field. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and requires a school-packed lunch, please contact the school office.

The cost of the day will be **£17.50** per pupil. Contributions can be made on your child's Arbor account under the trip section. Please note that payment will need to be completed by 9:00 am on Friday 3rd July. If we do not receive sufficient contributions, the trip will unfortunately have to be cancelled.

We are very much looking forward to providing this exciting experience for our Year 6 pupils and are confident it will be a wonderful way to create lasting memories before they move on to secondary school.
