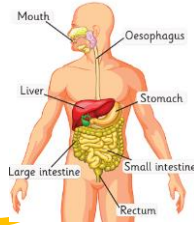


Science:

RE:

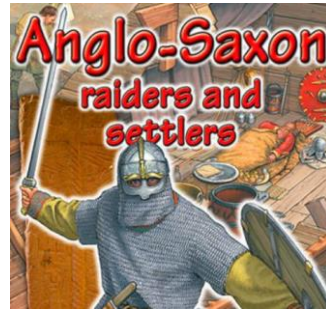
The Jewish faith will be our focus for the term as we consider the key concepts of 'Freedom' and 'Ritual'.
