The Department for Education has produced a document which summarises the attendance responsibilities for parents, schools and governing bodies, and local authorities, as ____outlined in their 'Working together to improve school attendance' guidance.

Parents are expected to:

Ensure their child attends every day the school is open except when a statutory reason applies.

Notify the school as soon as possible when their child has to be unexpectedly absent (e.g. sickness).

Only request leave of absence in exceptional circumstances and do so in advance.

Book any medical appointments around the school day where possible. Make sure that they are in school everyday, on time.

Please help your AJS child:

Phone the office by 8.30am if your child is going to be off school.

If we do not hear from you, we will first call <u>all</u> named contacts on our records.

If needed, we will then carry out a home visit, and then, if we have still not had contact with you. we will contact the Police.

The Police may then carry out an emergency welfare check visit.

Plan family holidays within the 12 weeks of school holidays
Please do not book holidays during term time. Every day of
school that a child misses affects their learning progress.
