Kit List

Bedding

- Pillow
- Single duvet or sleeping bag (A base sheet will be provided).

Clothing

Take plenty of clothing in case of wet weather. Clothing should be old.

- Nightwear
- Underwear
- Socks, including over ankle length (extra pairs)
- 3 / 4 fleeces / Sweatshirts
- 3 T-shirts
- 3 Long sleeved T-shirt
- 3 pairs of old trousers (not jeans) 2 for activities, one for evening
- 2 pairs of shorts
- Waterproof jacket & trousers
- Baseball cap / Hat
- Woolly Hat
- Gloves
- 1 set of Disco Clothes
- 2 pairs of trainers (1 for wet activities)
- 1 pair of shoes or trainers for indoors
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Other Essentials

- Wash bag (soap & toothbrush etc.)
- 2 Large towels
- Torch & batteries
- Plastic bottle for drinks
- Lip balm
- Small Bag/Rucksack
- Labelled plastic bags / bin liners (for wet items)

Optional

- Top trumps / pack of cards
- Reading book
- Small game / drawing paper and crayons
- Teddy bear / cuddly toy

Please remember that your child will not be allowed to bring any of the following:

- Mobile phone /smart watches
- Camera
- Electronic equipment – including computers, handheld games, etc.
- Sweets and fizzy drinks

Departure

On the morning of departure - children will be asked to arrive at school from 8:30am via the school office and head to the gym where they will be met by the Year 5 team to drop off their luggage.

Medication

If your child requires medication during their time away, we must have written permission from the parent / carer; we cannot administer medication on verbal permission alone. This written permission must be given on the relevant permission form and include dosage instructions. Forms will be provided when dropping your child off.

All medication, whether it be homely or pharmaceutical, needs to be in its original, clearly identifiable packaging.

Prescribed medicines: We will only accept prescribed medicines that are in date, labelled with the prescription label, provided in the original container as dispensed by the pharmacist and include instructions for administration, dosage and storage.

Pocket money

There is a small gift shop on site and your child is welcome to bring £5 in pocket money that they can spend on gifts for family or small souvenirs. Please ensure that this £5 is in a named envelope and handed to a staff member on the departure morning. Do not give your child more than £5 as they will not need it.
