

### We have a duty of care towards pupils and staff in school with nut allergies.

People who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction.

If someone has a nut allergy, it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts

or a product containing nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock (which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties).

First aid staff in the school are trained to use the Epi-pens (an injection of adrenalin) which is required immediately if this happens.

We do ask for your support in keeping AJS a nut free zone.









Please note that penalty notices can be issued to parents in these circumstances:

- Holiday taken during term time
- Children who are persistently late for school
- Children who are persistently late after registration closes.



### **CHANGES TO DOODLE ACCESS- PLEASE READ:**

Doodle was initially purchased by the school as an online home-learning tool during the school lockdowns of 2020 and 2021.

### <u>Please help your AJS child :</u>

### Parents are expected to:

Ensure their child attends every day the school is open except when a statutory reason applies.

Notify the school as soon as possible when their child has to be unexpectedly absent (e.g. sickness).

Only request leave of absence in exceptional circumstances and do so in advance.

Book any medical appointments around the school day where possible. Make sure that they are in school everyday, on time.

Phone the office by 8.30am if your child is going to be off school.

If we do not hear from you, we will first call <u>all</u> named contacts on our records.

If needed, we will then carry out a home visit, and then, if we have still not had contact with you. we will contact the Police.

The Police may then carry out an emergency welfare check visit.

Plan family holidays within the 12 weeks of school holidays
Please do not book holidays during term time. Every day of
school that a child misses affects their learning progress.
