**We have a duty of care towards
pupils and staff in school with nut allergies.**

People who suffer from nut allergies can develop a severe, potentially life-threatening allergic reaction.

If someone has a nut allergy, it is not just eating nuts that can cause a severe reaction, just being touched on the skin or smelling the breath of someone who has had nuts or a product containing nuts can trigger anaphylactic shock (which can cause breathing and swallowing difficulties).

First aid staff in the school are trained to use the Epi-pens (an injection of adrenalin) which is required immediately if this happens.

**We do ask for your support in keeping AJS
a nut free zone.**

FREE TRANSPORT ASSISTANCE-Children with SEND

The County Council understands that for a minority of children, particularly those with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), there are exceptional reasons why they are unable to get to school, even with the help of families or friends. In these situations, the County Council may be able to provide free transport assistance. This is available for eligible children from **the term after their fifth birthday up to and including year 11.**

You can visit the Hampshire County Council website to [check whether your child is eligible for free transport assistance](#). If you believe your child meets the eligibility criteria, and you need help getting them to school, you can [apply now for transport assistance](#) for the 2024/25 school year.

Application Deadline

To ensure your transport application is on time, you must submit it by **30 June 2024**. This is subject to an Education, Health and Care Plan or in the process of having one agreed. If the EHCP is finalised after this date, then the application will be treated as an on-time application.

IMPORTANT - The 30 June deadline applies only to children with SEND. The deadline for children in mainstream schools has already passed.

If your child already receives School Transport, **you don't need to do anything** unless your circumstances have changed. If you have moved home or school location, you will need to [reapply for transport](#).

Late application: Applications received after the deadline will be treated as late applications, and will only be reviewed after all on-time applications have been processed. This means that **transport will not be in place for September 2024 and may not be available for the first academic term.**

Providing your application is submitted on time, you can expect to hear back from us with the outcome of your application within 15 working days. This may vary during busier periods. For approved applications, you will then receive a second communication detailing your child's transport arrangements, and this will be sent to you no later than the end of August.
