Thank you to the parents who volunteered to help walk the children to and from the library.

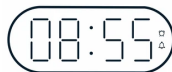

## The Clean Air Scooter Challenge 2024!

We are delighted that the **Clean Air Scooter Challenge** is back again this year. The challenge week encompasses **Clean Air Day** (20 June) and will focus on clean air and other benefits of scooting and active travel.



### The challenge

To get as many children as possible scooting from **17 to 21 June 2024**. Children will be encouraged to scoot to school, Scoot from the Boot\* or find any other opportunities to scoot throughout the week.

### The competition

There are some fantastic prizes to be won in the 'Scooter Scrapbook' competition. The winning school can choose from a Scooterpod, a set of scooters with helmets or scooter training equipment. There will also be a choice of runner-up prizes including scooter locks or a scooter with a helmet.

Schools will be asked to encourage their pupils to scoot as much as possible during the event. This could be achieved by:

- promoting the event
- a 'bling my wheels' event and parade
- a pupil-led poster campaign showing the benefits of scooting

- an active travel breakfast
- scooting skills at breaks
